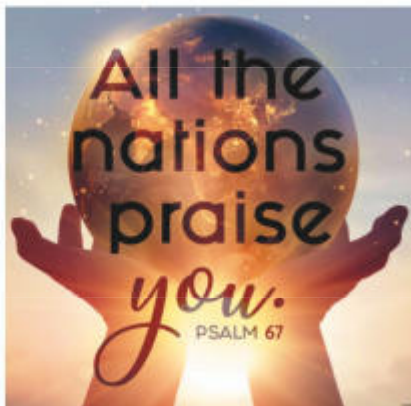
FIRST READING: Isaiah 56:1, 6-7

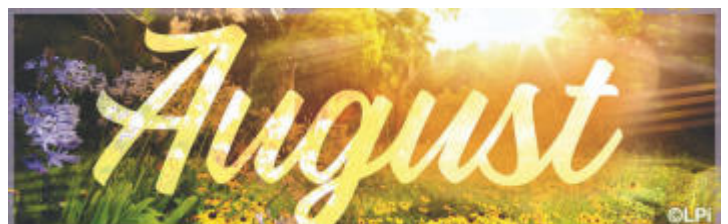
