
This is what I want for my kids. May they find their success by discerning God's will and becoming the wonderful people that God intended.



### **Our Catholic Heritage**

96th Pope – Leo III

Born in Rome, he was threatened and taken prisoner by supporters of his predecessor Adrian I. Freed by the Roman people, he then took refuge in France. He was elected on December 27, 795, and asked for Charlemagne's intervention before taking office in St. Peter's. In recognition, Leo III crowned Charlemagne as Emperor on Christmas Eve of the year 800. This coronation was not approved by Constantinople; however, Byzantines were in no position to offer much opposition. With the privilege of crowning sovereigns, the Pope acquired religious authority above the Emperor. This reconstituted the Empire



of the West and became known as the Holy Roman Empire. He later founded the Palatine School from which was derived the University of Paris. Pope Leo III died June 12, 816.

By tradition Joachim and Anne are considered to be the names of the parents of Mary, the Mother of God. We have no historical evidence, however, of any elements of their lives, including their names. Any stories about Mary's father and moth-



er come to us through tradition. Devotion to St. Anne grew in Europe through a popular French tradition. The French believed that Mary Magdalene, Lazarus, Martha, and other friends of Jesus crossed the Mediterranean Sea and landed at the southern French city of Marseilles where they spread the news about Jesus' death and resurrection. According to this tradition, Mary Magdalene's group brought with them the remains of St. Anne.

## Prayer Intention of Pope Francis for July

### **Gospel Meditation**

**Encourage Deeper Understanding of Scripture** 



Patience is rooted in Hope (an image of a bush filled with birds would be great). Life, like the church, is often burdened with evil, smallness, and impurities. The Lord's parables give us a hope-filled perspective on all three.

Evil: in Jesus' parable about the good farmer whose enemy plants weeds at night, Jesus tells us that God is not the cause of evil but permits evil to exist with good out of his patient love. He will finally deal with it, but his love lets things stay messy for a time.

Smallness: It's funny that Jesus says his kingdom looks like ... wait for it ... a bush. What a letdown! Yet this little shrub still somehow has room for all the birds of the sky. The smallness of the Church, and even our own little lives, still provides plenty of room for all whom God sends.

Impurities: divisions and hypocrisies in the Church and our own hearts exasperate us. Recall that Jesus compares his kingdom to a lump of dough with impure leaven eating away at it and therefore making it expand. It's the secret of the Cross. Not how we'd prefer it. But finally, great news.

The field, the bush, the loaf: all three parables invite us to embrace a patience rooted in hope: one day the field will be weeded, the bush filled with birds, and the risen loaf leaven-free.




