# What's Happening Here

Dear Holy Family,

Thank you for allowing me to serve in your community. Since I joined the staff here at Holy Family on March 9, it has been anything but normal. Due to the Pandemic and the consequential limitations of social distancing, it has made this experience unusual to say the least.



As I was readying to retire from my secular career at the beginning of this year, Fr. Joe and I began to discuss how I may be of service to this community and him, in order to best serve you, God's people. Based on my strong background in organizational structure, planning and process, Fr. Joe and I felt my gifts would be best utilized in organizing the staff and processes to make us operationally efficient. In simple terms, empower and hold accountable our staff. The goal is to allow our priests to be priest while the staff take responsibility for the secular activities.

We have created a process that allows us to meet regularly to communicate among the senior leaders who then in turn have the responsibility to communicate with their teams. This has proven to be very beneficial during this very fluid time of changes from the COVID-19 health and safety issues.

The staff and I are getting used to this change and working to improve it daily. We are seeing some good progress, but have a ways to go.

The commitment I made to Fr. Joe and the Holy Family community, last year, is to work as the Parish's Business Administrator through June 2021. My wife and I have recently become grandparents for the first time. We are in the process of moving back home to Wisconsin to be closer to our children and granddaughter. It is important to emphasize that through this my commitment to the Church of the Holy Family has not wavered. I will continue to be working for this community until June of 2021.

One thing that the pandemic has taught us is to work effectively through virtual means. My intent is to split my time physically between Grand Blanc and our new home in Wisconsin, but working full time for the Parish. Our organization and technology allows us to do this successfully.

Hopefully, as we recover from this virus we will be able to better socialize and I will finally get to meet many of you.

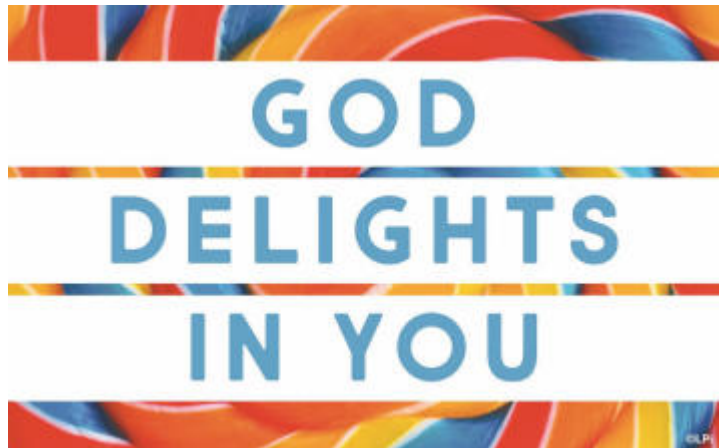

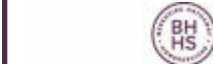
