My soul is thirsting, my soul is thirsting, my soul is thirsting for you, O Lord my God.

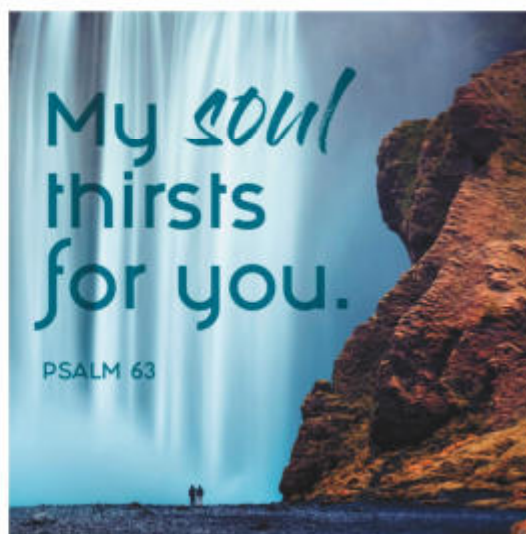
SECOND READING: *Romans 12:1-2*

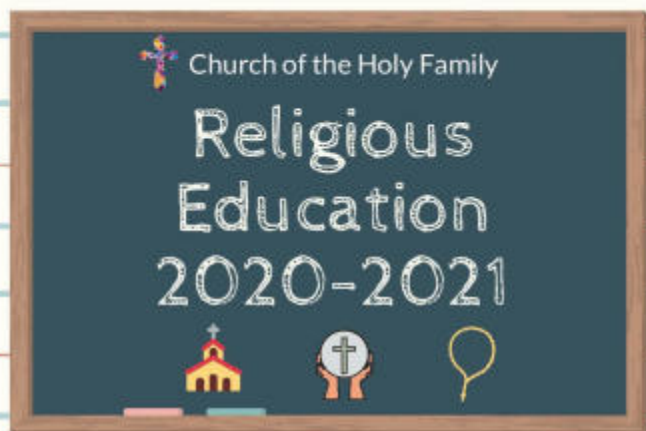

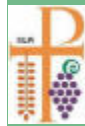

Are there still restrictions?

- Masks are encouraged.
- Singing is still not encouraged
- Bathroom use is discouraged
- If possible, please bring your own cleaning wipes
- Holy Communion cannot be taken to the homebound
- If you receive the Eucharist on the tongue, please kneel, raise your chin for the priest.

Will I still be able to watch Mass at home?

Yes! We will continue to livestream our 8 am Masses Monday Saturday and our 10 am Mass on Sunday. *Our Bishop has extended the dispensation through September 6th.* Elderly, people who are ill or have health issues, and children under seven years old are asked to not attend Mass.

What about confessions?
