

#### St. Michael the Archangel



#### Our Catholic Heritage



#### 56th Pope - John II

Born in Rome, he was elected on January 2, 533. His given name was Mercurius and he was the first pope to change his name once elected. Through an edict of Athalaric, the pope was recognized as the head of the bishops of the whole world. He fought against simony (the act of selling sacred objects or ecclesiastical titles). He convened a council on the readmission of Arian clergy, and formulated an important theory reaffirming the principle that only the human part of Christ had suffered martyrdom. During his pontificate, John II notably removed the notoriously adulterous Bishop Contumeliosus of Riez from his office and confined him in a monastery. John II died May 8, 535, and was buried in the Vatican Grottoes

#### October 18: St. Luke

There are only a few certain facts about St. Luke's life. We know him best as the author of the third gospel and of the Acts of the Apostles. A Greek himself, he wrote the story of Jesus and the Christian community for Gentile readers. He also accompanied St. Paul on some of his journeys and shared in his sufferings. Probably a physician, Luke may have pioneered as an early member of the church at Antioch. He aimed his books to persuade Gentiles that the Christian story was true. So he made it more accessible to them by filling his gospel with accounts of Christ's openness and mercy. Tradition says Luke lived a long life without



marrying and that he died at age eighty-four.



# Gospel Meditation Encourage Deeper Understanding of Scripture



Brendan wouldn't stop. He continued nagging his mom to let him have a little more time with his phone. He knew the rules, but wanted to finish a game and text a few more friends. He begged, had a temper tantrum, pleaded, screamed, pouted, and used every means he could think of to get Mom to change her mind. Mom had a busy day and was tired. At first, she held her ground. Then, her son's persistence got the best of her, and she caved. "Brendan, you can have 30 more minutes and no more!" she retorted. Brendan's determination paid off. He won.

Is this how it works with God too? If we want something enough and feel it is our due, does our persistence allow us to eventually get our way? Judging God by human standards, it would seem so. But is this the way God works? It gets a bit confusing when Jesus tells his disciples to "pray always without becoming weary" and then further tells them how God will "secure the rights of his chosen ones who call out to him day and night." If we catch God at the right time, when he's having a weak moment, then our tenacity ought to pay off. What we want, we will get. Really? Sadly, the way many approach prayer suggests that this is precisely how it goes.

Good parents set boundaries and offer proper discipline. They learn the art of being steadfast when presented with determined minds and wills. They know what is best and, at times, have to say "no." God is always there with His full attention and unconditional love showering itself upon us. God also knows what is best. And, as with any good parent, the one constant that is always available and never withheld is love. We can be as persistent and determined as we want if what we are seeking is God's love. We are never a bother and requests for God's love are never denied. This is the prayer of the heart. Desiring God alone and not only what we want God to do for us places this love relationship foremost in our minds, hearts, and souls. God is never bothered by this prayer. As we breathe in and exhale out, the Divine Life freely flows.

# Required for Those Entering a Second Marriage

There is a new marriage preparation requirement for couples entering into a second union, whether following death of previous spouse or a previous nulled marriage.

Typical marriage education programs and ministries are not sufficient for couples entering into blended family marriages. Since marriage in a stepfamily is a "package deal," you must minister to both the couple and "the package." This requires addressing dynamics related to ex-spouses and co-parenting, loss, stepparenting, spiritual shame, finances, and the expectations of both children and adults-just to name a few." To do anything less is grossly inadequate to prevent divorce.

The Smart Stepfamilies program, created by author, therapist, and blended family expert Ron L. Deal, brings together these different aspects a stepfamily will encounter, in order to empower blended family couples and their extended family for successful family living.

The Remarriage Retreat is a way for couples to come together in a non-threatening setting to learn about the challenges that will be experienced, as well as children entering into a stepfamily. It is also an opportunity for a couple to, possibly for the first time, begin to focus on previously unknown information or previously undiscussed topics that will bring challenges and begin the process of sharing with each other how this will be addressed within their new family dynamic.

All the Facilitators have journeyed through the trials and blessings of living in their own blended family and are willing to share their stories and help with the questions the attending couples may have.
