



159th Pope - Urban II

Born in France, he was elected March 12, 1088. The council of Clairmont conclave had to be held in Velletri because Rome was in the hands of the anti-pope Clement III. He followed a strategy of diplomatic policy, aimed at isolating



Henry IV. He declared war on the infidels and was the inspirer of the first crusade which was undertaken to free the Holy Land from the Turks. He instituted the "Truce of God," a brief pause in battle to bury the dead. Pope Urban II died July 29, 1099, just a few days after Jerusalem was taken back.



October 11: St. John XXIII

John XXIII was pope for only a short time (1959 to 1963), but had an amazing impact on the church and the entire world. 


