



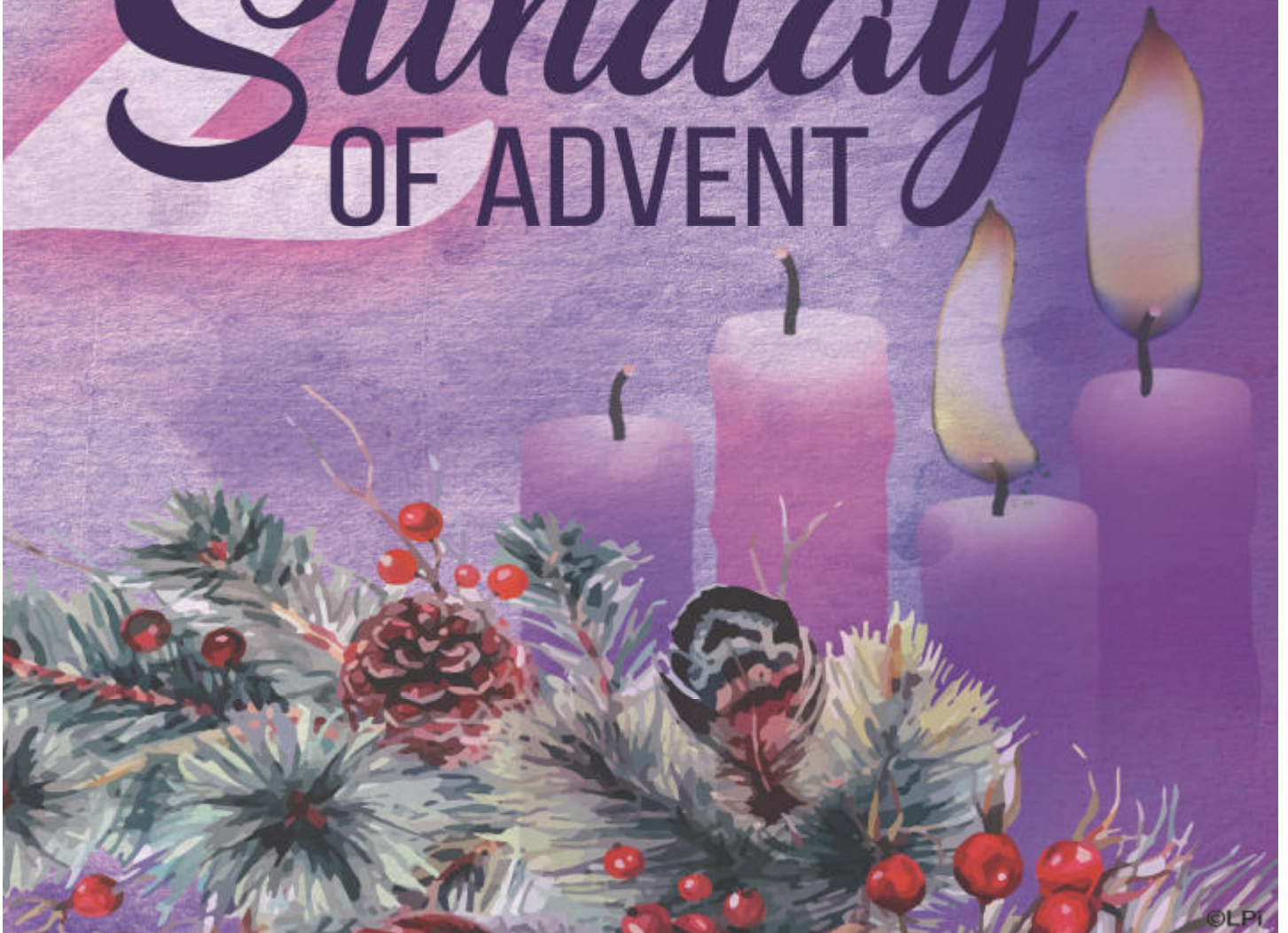

## Second Sunday of Advent

### ENTRANCE HYMN

### FIRST READING: *Isaiah 40:1-5,9-11*

Comfort, give comfort to my people,  
says your God.  
Speak tenderly to Jerusalem, and proclaim to her  
that her service is at an end, her guilt is expiated;  
indeed, she has received from the hand of the  
LORD double for all her sins.  
A voice cries out:  
In the desert prepare the way of the LORD!  
Make straight in the wasteland a highway for our  
God!  
Every valley shall be filled in, every mountain and  
hill shall be made low; the rugged land shall be  
made a plain, the rough country, a broad valley.  
Then the glory of the LORD shall be revealed,  
and all people shall see it together;  
for the mouth of the LORD has spoken.  
Go up on to a high mountain, Zion, herald of glad  
tidings; cry out at the top of your voice,  
Jerusalem, herald of good news!  
Fear not to cry out and say to the cities of Judah:  
Here is your God!  
Here comes with power the Lord GOD, who rules  
by his strong arm; here is his reward with him,  
his recompense before him.  
Like a shepherd he feeds his flock; in his arms he  
gathers the lambs, carrying them in his bosom,  
and leading the ewes with care.

### SECOND READING: *2 Peter 3:8-14*

Do not ignore this one fact, beloved, that with the

wishing that any should perish but that all should  
come to repentance.  
But the day of the Lord will come like a thief, and

Since everything is to be dissolved in this way,  
what sort of persons ought you to be, conducting  
yourselves in holiness and devotion, waiting for

But according to his promise we await new  
heavens and a new earth in which righteousness  
dwells.  
Therefore, beloved, since you await these things,  
be eager to be found without spot or blemish  
before him, at peace.

with the Holy Spirit."

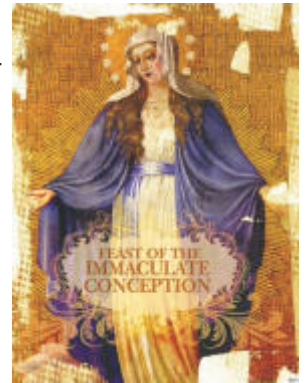

Holy Family Parish has accepted the names of 200 children (60 families) from the North End Soup Kitchen as part of their annual Angel Tag program.

This is a wonderful opportunity to bring love and cheer to those most in need. It's our privilege to be able to do it.

How it works:

- Choose an angel tag(s) from the tree which is located in the right corner of the large hall as you enter. Tags will be available after Masses starting with the Saturday Mass following Thanksgiving, Nov. 28th. (**\*all tags have been taken.\***)
- Purchase your gift(s) for each child. Suggested amount is \$30-\$40 per child. Please keep in mind there may be several items requested. These are simply ideas; you do not have to purchase all items requested. Gift cards are appropriate for anyone over 15.
- Wrap your gift(s). Cut the top portion of your tag and attach it to your wrapped gift, making sure the child's first name and the code identifier is visible. This identifies the child's family and makes it easier to gather all gifts for that family in one bundle.

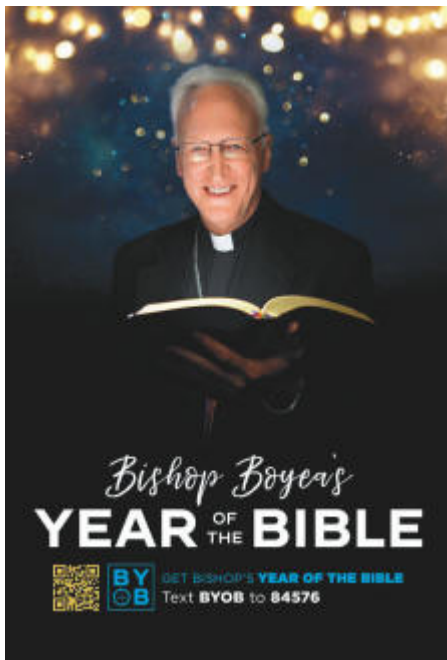

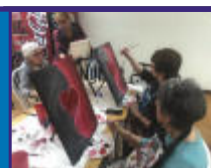

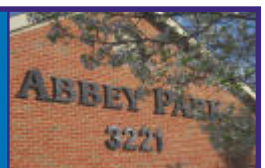
