



## A CUP OF JOE

Greetings in Christ, all!

I want to give you an update on something and I'll need to lead into it.

So, as most of you know, I am hearing impaired. I have really good, cutting-edge hearing aids and it helps a lot. I do okay between those and looking at people's mouths when they talk. At the same time, I recognize that



my hearing is going to get worse. Profound hearing impairment is a part of my family history and mine gets worse every year. I love hearing confessions and I think it's one of the most important things I can do as a priest.

Lately, it's becoming more and more difficult for me. On Saturdays in particular, Fr. Le and I will be in the confessional for hours and I walk out with a headache from straining to hear. When I do children's confessions, I generally can't hear most of it.

Knowing my plight, one of our parishioners put in a hearing assist system for me to try. On your side of the confessional is a wired connection to my side. If I am struggling to hear or understand someone, I can put headphones on and then I can hear. This is a closed, wired system that is 100% secure on my side of the confessional. I am going to try it out and see if it works and if it does, I will then check with Church Law and see if it's something I can keep using.

If this makes you even moderately uncomfortable, I need you to let the parish office know. I do not want anyone to avoid confession because of me as that would break my heart.

For the next couple of weeks, I will let people who come into the confessional know if I am going to turn the system on and ask if it makes them uncomfortable. It is my sincerest hope that if I ask you and you are even a little uncomfortable, please just say, "No thank you." It will not offend me at all, I want to serve you well.

I do often pray that I get to retain sufficient hearing ability to continue in public ministry for at least 10 more years. Please join me in that prayer, unless I drive you nuts... haha.

Okay, so that's it for today. We have a lot of wonderful things happening at the parish, but I lack the time to type up all of them...maybe next week!

Jesus bless you all. I just love being your priest.

#### **Our Catholic Heritage**

by Earl Hagen 178th Pope Gregory IX (1227-41)

Gregory IX became pope on March 19, 1227. Born in Anagni, his exact date of birth is not known. His birth name was Ugolino di Conti. Pope for more than 14 years, one of the longest-serving popes of the century. Gregory IX was also for the Northern Crusades because he believed the



wars would bring more men to the Church.

Pope Gregory IX is one of the only popes in history to excommunicate the same person twice. He excommunicated Holy Roman Emperor Frederick II for his attitude towards the Crusade. Gregory IX was the pope responsible for canonizing Elizabeth of Hungary and making her a saint. He canonized her on May 25, 1235.

As history did not record his exact date of birth, Gregory IX was either 57 or 71 when he became pope and either 82 or 96 when he passed away.

Gregory IX died on August 22, 1241, in Rome, Italy.

Holy Moments Explained -

THE PROGRESS DELUSION

All progress involves change, but not all change is progress. Change is inevitable, progress is not. History demonstrates this repeatedly and with the demise and extinction of whole civilizations. Change can just as easily lead to stagnation, regression, deterioration, and extinction. These alternatives make it clear that discerning the path that leads to genuine progress is one of the greatest challenges every society faces (and every person).

Our ability to meet this challenge rests upon our moral and spiritual qualities. Many people would like to believe that progress is solely dependent on our intellectual capacity to innovate and that our moral character is irrelevant to the quest. This simply isn't true. To look beyond our own self-ish interests and toward the common good, with a goal of accomplishing the most good for the most people, moral character is not only necessary it is essential. The idea of genuine progress being accomplished by people who are morally indifferent is lunacy.



#### Saint

#### February 21: St. Peter Damian

Peter escaped poverty and the neglect of his own brother when his other brother, who was archpriest of Ravenna, took him under his wing. His brother sent him to good schools and Peter became a professor. Soon, he decided to leave his teaching and give himself completely to prayer with the Benedictines of the reform of Saint Romuald at Fonte Avellana. They lived two monks to a hermitage. Peter was so eager to pray and slept so little that he soon suf-



fered from severe insomnia. He found he had to use some prudence in taking care of himself. When he was not praying, he studied the Bible. The abbot commanded that when he died Peter should succeed him. Abbot Peter founded five other hermitages. He wrote many letters. Some 170 survive. We also have 53 of his sermons and seven lives, or biographies, which he wrote. He preferred examples and stories rather than theory in his writings. The liturgical offices he wrote are evidence of his talent as a stylist in Latin.






