

St. Michael the Archangel




WHAT'S HAPPENING HERE



Saint

May 12: St. Nereus and Achilleus and St. Pancras St. Nereus and Achilleus were at first enrolled in the military tribunal, but both left the military once they had converted to the faith. For this faith they were condemned to death, probably during the reign of Diocletian. Their sepulcher is preserved in the cemetery on the Ardeatine Way where a basilica has been construct-

ed in their honor.



St. Pancras died at Rome probably during the Diocletian persecution. He was beheaded at the age of 14. His tomb over which Pope Symmachus built a church is preserved on the Aurelian Way.

Our Catholic Heritage

85th Pope - John VI

Born in Ephesus, he was elected pope on October 30, 701. In an extremely difficult period for Christianity, John VI had strained relations with Emperor Justinian II who tried to influence papal decisions. John II was in strong oppositions to the Emperor and had the support of the Italian people who were tired of being prevaricated upon by Constantinople's policies and had started to take their distance. The Turks had begun



to expand into Europe, posing grave dangers to Christians. They were rejected in the East and in Spain by the Saracens, he defended the prerogatives of the Church against the Emperor, and ransomed many slaves. Pope John VI died January 11, 705.

St. Cecilia Music Scholarship

Musically gifted students in high school, college and graduate school can be eligible for St. Cecilia Music Scholarship through our parish as a singer or an instrumentalist. The St. Cecilia Scholarship is funded by various parishioners and groups to promote the ministries of the young musicians who are willing to share their time and talents through our musical and liturgical ministries.

To apply for the scholarship, applicants must have a musical skill or potential, and be willing to share it at our parish liturgies and services. The application letter may be emailed to Dr. Simon Lee at musicdirector@hfgb.org or delivered to the parish office by May 31. A brief audition and interview with our Music Ministry Project Committee may be scheduled in June.

To selected students, the scholarship of \$500-1,500 will be awarded to each student and Dr. Simon Lee may offer free music lessons during this summer.

No Neighbor Left Behind

Thank you to Holy Family Church, all parishioners, donors, and those who help with pickups and deliveries.

The Knights helped 38 families and 4 different outreaches/ organizations in April providing them with over 310 items. We have 70 families waiting for us to find and deliver items for them. We especially need pots and pans, beds, bunk beds, dressers, appliances (washers, etc.), couches, and kitchen table. We cannot deliver what we have in storage fast enough.
