

## A CUP OF JOE

Greetings in Christ, all!

I'm more or less back and so grateful! The procedure on my knee went well. They found I had torn the meniscus in two places, my ACL, and I had a cyst in a sensitive spot. They dealt with all of it and I am feeling so much better. Thanks for your prayers and your patience. I hate not being able to serve you in the manner you deserve; being a part of



this Holy Family has been one of the best gifts Jesus has ever given me and I never feel like I'm able to show that to you on the level I feel it.

This is Corpus Christi Sunday, or in English, "The Feast of the Body and Blood of Jesus." Everything we do is because of the Eucharist, through the Eucharist and in imitation of this amazing mystery of a God who gives Himself to us in the form of bread. We will hit on the theological elements of this in the homily, but use the bulletin article here to do some practical things to help us.

If you come to Mass, you'll notice that most times, communion takes quite a while. There's a simple reason for this: there are a lot of people going to communion! I am working on moving us toward installing a communion rail that we can use at Mass. The nice thing about a communion rail is that if your preference is to stand, you can stand, and if your preference is to kneel, you can kneel. Communion rails move the line much quicker as well, without rushing people. I'll obviously keep you updated on this as we move closer to the day it comes. In the meantime, I urge us to remember how special and sacred the time is when we receive communion.

Let's look at some practical things:

You can receive standing or kneeling. Both are permitted and no priest can forbid what the Church allows. You can receive in the hand or on the tongue. Both are permitted and no priest can forbid what the Church allows. If you receive in your hand, please avoid cupping your hands. Instead, place your dominant hand under your non-dominant hand and make a throne. The priest will place the host on your non-dominant hand and you can use your dominant hand to pick it up and place it in your mouth. If you receive on the tongue, please lift your chin and extend your tongue. It's a challenge when people do not do this. We ask these things because the Eucharist is very, very special, and we do not want it to hit the floor.

If you are not Catholic, but want to receive the Eucharist, please call the Parish Office and ask for Deacon Dan; he'll hook you up!

Thanks for reading this and processing it. The Eucharist is God's Best Gift to us; we want to make sure that we give it due honor and dignity.

I want to close by again thanking you with all my heart for your beautiful response to our 40 hours of Eucharistic devotion. I just can't get out of my head and heart how much your response touched me and gave me strength. Thank you also for your generous response to our call for gifts for Fr. Le. You guys are amazing!







## WHAT'S HAPPENING HERE

### **Gospel Meditation**

**Encourage Deeper Understanding of Scripture** 



A Catholic friend of mine occasionally says, "The Eucharist is not a noun. It's a verb." In so saying, he is making the point that the Eucharist isn't simply Jesus' bodily presence given to us in holy Communion. It also manifests the dynamic pattern by which Christ actively loves and saves us. He teaches us to cooperate with that pattern. This Eucharist actually embodies four verbs: Jesus takes, blesses, breaks, and gives. Let's consider each one.

He **takes**: Do we acknowledge that we are totally in God's hands? Do we receive everything in our lives as a gift, and act responsibly with it?

He **blesses**: Do we actively reflect that Jesus makes us holy in our baptism? Do we embrace our bodies and souls as temples of God, worthy of love, peace, and joy?

He **breaks**: Do we run from failure and disappointment, from getting old or being ignored? Are we too worried about getting hurt or sick? Do we embrace our sufferings with confidence?

He **gives**: Are we willing to make our lives a gift for others? Are we confident that we will always have enough love to give to others, that God will always provide enough for us? Do we rejoice in giving away what we have to others, expecting nothing in return? This is the dynamic life the Eucharist empowers us to live.





### **Our Catholic Heritage**

*by Earl Hagen* **196th Pope - John XXII** (1316-34)

Pope John XXII, born around 1244 in Cahors, a bustling town in southern France. His birth name was Jacques Duèze and he came from a modest, but well-connected family. His father was a shoemaker, which, surprisingly, led the family's rise to prominence. Displaying an early apti-



tude for learning, he pursued studies in law and theology. He was a reformer, a scholar, and a patron of the arts. He was a figure of both reverence and controversy, whose papacy left an indelible mark on the Catholic Church.

Upon his election, Pope John XXII shared half of his predecessor's wealth (Pope Clement V) with the cardinals who supported him. Known for his strong administrative skills, John was deeply involved in European politics and religion, often asserting papal authority over non-Catholic leaders. He canonized Louis of Toulouse in 1317 and expressed gratitude to Uzbeg Khan, a Muslim ruler who treated Christians kindly.

Known for reorganizing the Church and implementing strict governance, he was a man of sharp intellect and unyielding determination. His reign was marked by theological debates, political maneuvering, and a relentless drive to consolidate papal authority. He served as a chancellor to the King of Naples before becoming pope.

Pope John XXII died on December 4, 1334, (aged 89–90) which made him one of the oldest Popes to serve.

#### Saint

#### June 28: St. Irenaeus

St. Irenaeus was born around the year 130. Educated at Smyrna, he became the disciple of St. Polycarp, bishop of that city. In the year 177 he was ordained a priest at Lyons in France and shortly thereafter was made bishop of that city. He composed works defending the Catholic faith against errors of the Gnostics, and it is said that he received the martyr's crown around the year 200.






