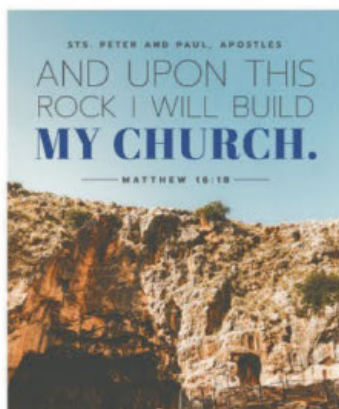

Seven years ago on July 1st, I moved here. I mark it on my calendar so that I can take time and rejoice. I simply don't have the words that would sufficiently express the depths of my gratitude to God for all of you and for the joy of being your priest.

To that end, we have statues of Saints in various places, we have First Class Relics of Saints in the front; we have rosaries, religious medals and even a damaged chalice right in the concrete that our sanctuary is built on, and we even have religious medals in the floor of the Church.

When you look at our floor, you'll see tiles shaped as crosses laid into the floor. Wherever you see a cross, there is a medal of a saint beneath it. This is a very old custom that I wanted to be sure we honored in our construction. On pages 6 and 7 in the bulletin is a handout that tells you which saint medal is where: be sure to check it out!


So that is it for this week. Thank you for letting me serve you. I love you all very much.

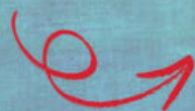

The Saints Among Us

When we were praying about the design of the church, the Lord placed a scripture passage in our hearts from the Book of Hebrews. Part of that passage reads, "Since we are surrounded by this great cloud of witnesses..." It was in this spirit that we sought to ensure that whenever someone entered our church, they would find themselves surrounded by reminders of the Saints. We did this with statues and sacred art. We incorporated rosaries and Saint medals into the very concrete that makes up our sanctuary. Finally, we placed medals in the floor of the church, beneath each of the cross-shaped tiles. The Saints surround us at every moment we celebrate Mass. Their prayers and example cheer us on and give us hope. May we seize the grace that Jesus offers us each day, striving to become the next generation of Saints.

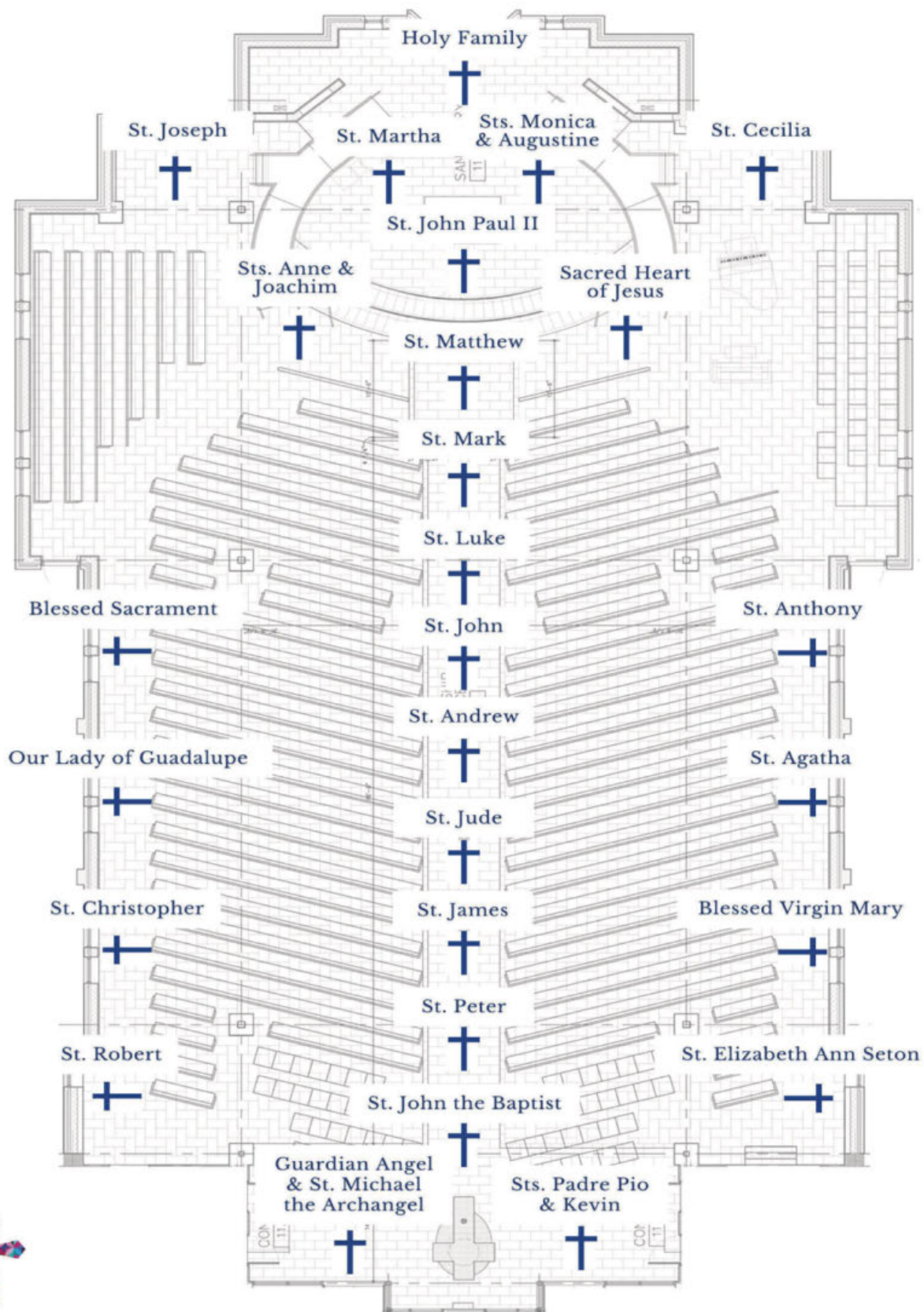

Our Catholic Heritage

197th Pope - Benedict XII
(1334-42)

Born near 1280-1285 in Saverdun, France. His birth name was Jacques Fornier. He became Pope December 30, 1334, after a conclave met in which more than half of the cardinals were in favor of choosing a cardinal who also served as the Bishop of Porto. Fearing the papacy would move back to Rome, the conclave spent more than a week before finally choosing Benedict XII.

He believed that monks should live in poverty and not have the benefits that they had at the time. One of the papal bulls he released stated that men should not expect to receive titles or the funds attached to those titles. This bull changed how they became priests and other religious leaders, as well as how they would get paid for those positions.

Some of the records written during and after his papacy claim that he was a hard man and a foe of the Church. Historians today believe this was because he wanted to return the papacy to Rome in direct opposition to other religious leaders at the time.

The papacy of Pope Benedict XII lasted for 2,683 days, or seven years and 126 days. This makes him one of the longest-reigning Popes of Avignon.

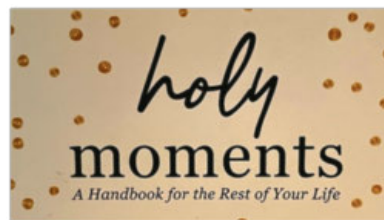
He died on April 25, 1342, around the age of 57.

June 30: First Martyrs of the Church of Rome

In the first persecution against the Church, begun by the Emperor Nero after the burning of Rome in 64, many of the faithful were tortured and slain. The pagan writer Tacitus testifies to these events in his *Annales* (15, 44), as does Clement, bishop of Rome, in his letter to the Corinthians (chapters 5-6).

The Divine Plan - God's Math Lesson

How many times have you thought about Holy Moments since you started reading this book? How many opportunities have you seized to create Holy Moments? How many Holy Moments have you witnessed?

There is something about the concept that is so powerful that simply becoming aware of it provides a new lens to see life through. It's invigorating, energizing, and hope-filled.

Still, if I asked you to go out and create a million Holy Moments, you would feel overwhelmed. This feeling would probably lead you to conclude that it is impossible for you to create a million Holy Moments. But is it? That depends on whose math class you take.

Can we change the world? Most people believe it is impossible. They believe the culture has become too powerful and nothing we can do will alter that. I don't believe that, and this is why. It's called the principle of Spiritual Multiplication.

Retreat Focuses on Two Mystics

Weber Retreat and Conference Center's annual in-person *Retreat on the Mystics*. It focuses on St. Francis de Sales and medieval Dominican mystic Meister Eckhart. The retreat begins at 6:00 p.m. **Sunday, July 27, 2025**, and concludes at 11:00 a.m. **Wednesday, July 30, 2025**.

The Bishop of Geneva and the "Doctor of Divine Love," St. Francis de Sales, taught people how to find God in their daily lives. Father Michael Newman, OSFS, a priest of the Order of St. Francis de Sales, is the Assistant Provincial of the Toledo-Detroit Province of the Oblates and pastor of Holy Family Parish in Adrian.

Dr. Anastasia Wendlinder, PhD, Associate Professor of Religious Studies at Gonzaga University in Spokane, Washington, delves into Meister Eckhart's multi-faceted writings and explores his relevancy today.

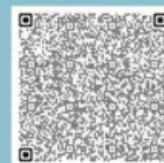

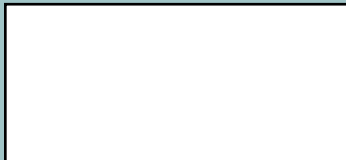
