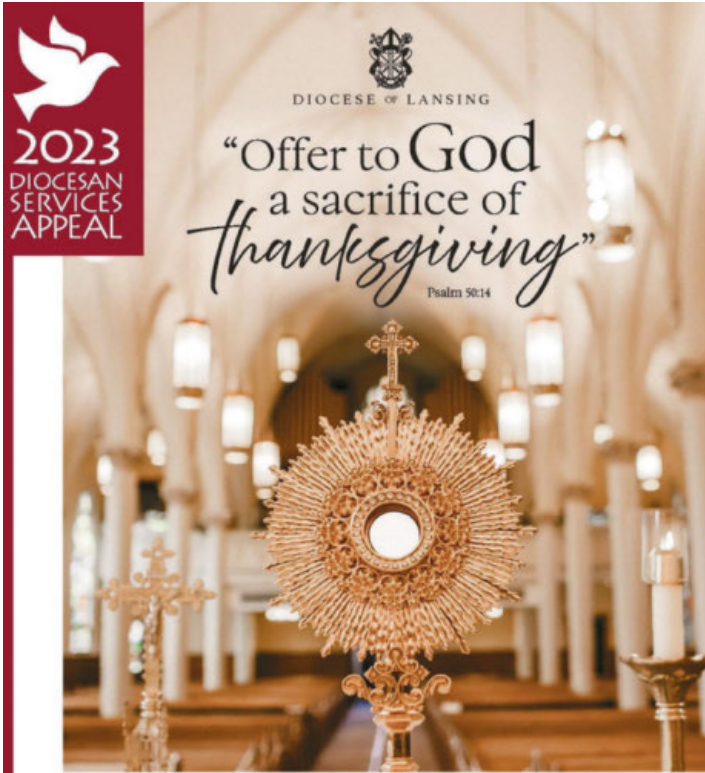

Our Catholic Heritage

89th Pope – Gregory II

Born in Rome, he was elected pope May 19, 715. In answer to the edict of Constantinople which forbid the cult of images, ordering their destruction. The iconoclastic sect was rejected by Italy, resulting in the Italian provinces rising up against the army of Leo III. This prepared the way for a long series of revolts, schisms, and civil wars. The Lombard King Liutprando who hoped to use the occasion to his advantage to get his hands on Rome, supported five Italian cities. United in a group known as Pentapoli, Gregory II managed to convince Liutprando to desist attacking Rome. These uprisings eventually led to the establishment of the "temporal power of the popes." Gregory II died February 11, 731, and was buried in St. Peter's Basilica.

Saint

June 6: St. Norbert

St. Norbert was born in the duchy of Cleves around the year 1080. A canon of the church of Xanten, he was converted from a worldly life after a close brush with death during a violent thunderstorm. He was ordained to the priesthood in 1115. Undertaking the apostolic life, he accepted the duty of preaching, particularly throughout France and Germany. Gathering together some companions, he laid the foundations of the Premonstratensian Order, for which he also founded monasteries. Elected Archbishop of Magdeburg in 1126, he reformed the Christian life and spread faith to nearby pagan nations. Saint Norbert died in 1134.

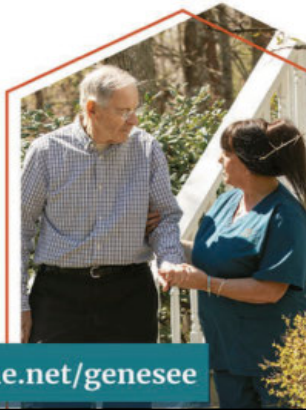
