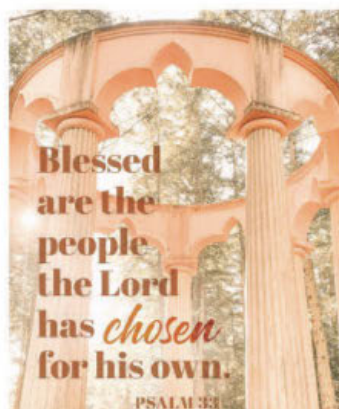

Greetings in Christ!

Thanks to all who prayed for me during my vacation. I really didn't do anything except read, sleep and swim (there was an indoor pool!). My knee feels great because I was in the pool for hours a day and it was wonderful.

You may remember I told you about a little kitten named Lucy living in our garage. She has a brother who is there too. I named him Bob. So now we have two cats, one of which I see every day (Bob) and one of whom never lets me see her (Lucy). I will win them over! I know a lot of people are telling me to sterilize them and I will, but right now they are too young: these two are tiny! I'm working with one of our parishioners and when it's time, I will trap them and get them taken care of. If either of these ferocious beasts approaches you, I've learned that the best defense is a belly rub.

On Friday of this week is the Feast of the Assumption of The Blessed Virgin Mary. This is a holy day of obligation and it's really important that we all come and pray. We will be praying this Mass Thursday at 6 pm and Friday at 8 am. Either of these will cover the obligation!

I wanted to make a couple of notes about our confession times. We are so very blessed to have retired priests helping us and the cool thing is, they really enjoy coming here. Because of them, we have three priests working on Wednesday confessions (5 - 6 pm) and three, sometimes four, on Saturday morning after the 8 am Mass. Here are a couple of ways you can help:

Please go to the next priest in line - don't ask people to switch so that you can go to your priest of preference. It puts people in an awkward position and, frankly, it isn't good for us as God's people or as priests. All of us priests are broken men striving for holiness and Jesus is in charge. Let Jesus pick who you are going to.

If you are thinking of returning to confession after a long time, this is your sign to do so! Jesus wants you free so very badly. Just tell the priest it has been a long time, and you need help, and we will be so happy to guide you through. Don't let fear hold you back from love!

When we make the line for confession, please make sure and keep a good distance from the confession doors. I'm significantly hearing impaired and when we get too close to the door, people will whisper. Let's make sure and back up the line so folks feel safe in their confidentiality!

I'm so proud to be your priest. I can't believe how many of you are willing to come and stand in line and wait just for


the opportunity to let Jesus forgive you and love you. Sometimes I find myself overwhelmed with joy at your striving. Praise God.

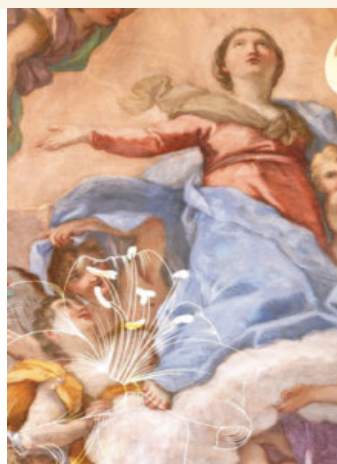
As always, thank you for letting me be your priest. You are God's Gift to me.

# WHAT'S HAPPENING HERE

## Family Formation

We are excited to introduce **Family Formation**, an exciting new model for Religious Education at Church of the Holy Family.

This dynamic, family-centered approach is rooted in the **Catechism of the Catholic Church** and brings children and parents together to grow in faith through shared experiences, prayer, and learning.

For grades **1st through 5th**, formation will meet **twice monthly on scheduled Sunday afternoons from 1:00 – 3:00 PM**. Sessions will begin in the St. Joseph Center with joint activities for the whole family. Parents will then gather for catechesis while children meet in classrooms by grade level. Sessions conclude with prayer and fellowship as one faith community.



Students in **6th, 7th, and 8th grades** will also meet during this time in a youth group-style format. Parents of these students are welcome to attend, but not required.

**Sacramental Preparation for First Reconciliation and First Communion** are included in Family Formation and will be introduced in the 2nd-grade sessions. The Parent meeting for these Sacraments will be held on Wednesday, September 17, 2025, following the 6:00 pm Mass.

**Confirmation Preparation** is not included in Family Formation. Students seeking Confirmation are invited to attend the Confirmation Parent/Student meeting on September 10, 2025, following the 6:00 pm Mass. Students in Confirmation Preparation are not required to enroll or participate in Family Formation.

### Enrollment is now open!

**Cost:** \$125 per family if registered **by September 1, 2025** (late registration is \$150). Fees include materials, snacks, beverages, and sacramental prep.

We provide families in need with furniture, beds, appliances, kitchen items, etc. In July, NNLB helped 94 families receive 902 household items, from dishes to appliances, including 75 kids/adults who we were able to deliver beds to. We were blessed by Powers High School sending seven volunteers and also some new volunteers from our parishes. For each day we get an extra volunteer, we can help four more families receive items. We could also use volunteers to sort bedding and unbox kitchenware.

We have **an opportunity to get 100 mattresses from a school in Davison**. If anyone can store 10-100 mattresses in their garage or pole barn, or other space, please contact Joe Buffa as we urgently need to find some free storage so we can get beds to families.

## Our Catholic Heritage

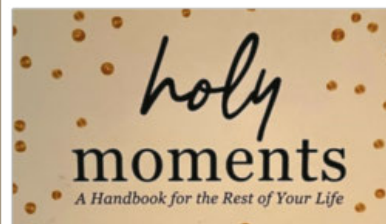
**203rd Pope - Boniface IX** (1389-1404) Born in Naples, Italy, between 1348 and 1350. Birth name Pietro Cybo Tomacelli. Considered illiterate due to no formal training, he became cardinal in 1381 and Pope on November 2, 1389, during the Western Schism when multiple individuals simultaneously claimed to be the true pope due to political factors. He took the name Boniface IX. Boniface IX, like many other popes, accepted money and gifts from others. Most of the gifts he received went to his family.



His rule was marked with many antipopes, Boniface IX (1389-1404), Robert of Geneva ("Clement VII") (1378-1394), Pedro de Luna ("Benedict XIII") (1394-1417) and Baldassare Cossa ("John XXIII") (1400-1415), all claiming to be true popes.

Benedict XIII sent an envoy of men to Rome to discuss possibly ending the schism. As he requested that Boniface IX step down from his position, he refused and sent the men away. When a group of penitents headed towards Rome, Boniface IX had their leader abducted and then burned at the stake. The man's followers then quickly left the city.

During his later years, the pope sided with Rupert as the new King of Germany. He also issued a decree regarding how the Church could sell property. Despite several people asking him to step down, Pope Boniface IX was pope for 14 years and 334 days. In 1404, he came down with an illness that caused him to spend several days in bed. Despite resting and taking care of himself, he never recovered. Pope Boniface IX died on October 1 of 1404, about age 53 or 54.

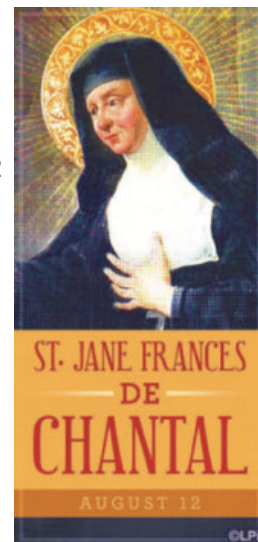

## Saint

**August 12: St. Jane Frances de Chantal** (1562-1641)

Widowed with four children at age 28, Jane prayed that God would send her a guide. When she was 32 she met St. Francis de Sales who became her spiritual director. They founded the Congregation of the Visitation, an institute of women which was a haven for those whose health, age, or other conditions barred them from entering the already existing communities. Jane's reputation for sanctity was widespread. There were 86 houses at the time of her death in 1641 and 164 when she was canonized in 1767.

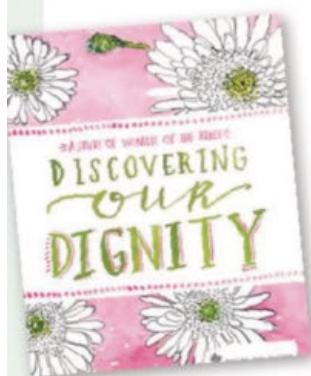

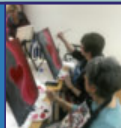

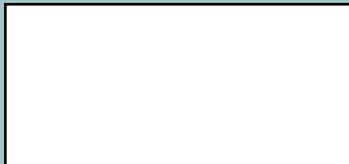
