



The Saints Among Us

When we were praying about the design of the church, the Lord placed a scripture passage in our hearts from the Book of Hebrews. Part of that passage reads, "Since we are surrounded by this great cloud of witnesses..." It was in this spirit that we sought to ensure that whenever someone entered our church, they would find themselves surrounded by reminders of the Saints. We did this with statues and sacred art. We incorporated rosaries and Saint medals into the very concrete that makes up our sanctuary. Finally, we placed medals in the floor of the church, beneath each of the cross-shaped tiles. The Saints surround us at every moment we celebrate Mass. Their prayers and example cheer us on and give us hope. May we seize the grace that Jesus offers us each day, striving to become the next generation of Saints.



WHAT'S HAPPENING HERE

Family Formation

We are excited to introduce **Family Formation**, an exciting new model for Religious Education at Church of the Holy Family.

This dynamic, family-centered approach is rooted in the **Catechism of the Catholic Church** and brings children and parents together to grow in faith through shared experiences, prayer, and learning.

For grades 1st through 5th, formation will meet twice monthly on scheduled Sunday afternoons from 1:00 – 3:00 PM. Sessions will begin in the St. Joseph Center with joint activities for the whole family. Parents will then gather for catechesis while children meet in class-



rooms by grade level. Sessions conclude with prayer and fellowship as one faith community.

Students in **6th**, **7th**, **and 8th grades** will also meet during this time in a youth group-style format. Parents of these students are welcome to attend, but not required.

Sacramental Preparation for First Reconciliation and First Communion are included in Family Formation and will be introduced in the 2nd-grade sessions. The Parent meeting for these Sacraments will be held on Wednesday, September 17, 2025, following the 6:00 pm Mass.

Confirmation Preparation is not included in Family Formation. Students seeking Confirmation are invited to attend the Confirmation Parent/Student meeting on September 10, 2025, following the 6:00 pm Mass. Students in Confirmation Preparation are not required to enroll or participate in Family Formation.

Enrollment is now open!

Cost: \$125 per family if registered by **September 1, 2025** (late registration is \$150). Fees include materials, snacks, beverages, and sacramental prep.



Our Catholic Heritage

204th Pope - Innocent VII (1404-06)

Born in 1339 in Sulmona, part of the Kingdom of Naples. Birth name Cosimo de' Migliorati. Studied civil and canon law, teaching law at Perugia and Padua Universities where a fellow teacher helped him get a job in Rome with Pope Urban VI. Slowly climbing the ranks, on October 17, 1404, he was unanimously elected by only eight cardinals as Pope Innocent VII. Positions he held before and during his reign included: Archbishop of Ravenna (1387-1389), Bishop of Bologna (1389-1390), Apostolic Administrator of Ravenna (1389-1400), Cardinal-Priest of Santa Croce in Gerusalemme (1389-1404), Camerlengo of the Sacred College of Cardinals (1396-1404). Upon his election, riots broke out, King Ladislaus of Naples quickly ended them. In gratitude, Pope Innocent VII made King Ladislaus the "Defender" of the Church, promising him he would not negotiate with the Antipope Benedict XIII unless he recognized the King's claims to Naples. Pope Innocent VII appointed his nephew Ludovico Migliorati as captain of the papal militia - a huge mistake. Not only was this nepotism at its finest, he was highly unqualified making matters worse. In August 1405, Ludovico captured and murdered in grisly fashion, 11 important Roman leaders who had just met with the Pope, causing such an uproar the Pope fled the city for his own safety. King Ladislaus and his troops restored calm to the city. Once the Romans realized Pope Innocent VII had nothing to do with the murders, they recognized his Papal authority upon his return to Rome. Innocent VII wanted to hold a council in Rome to end Western Schism. It was delayed citing he couldn't guarantee safety for the rival pope, Benedict XIII, if he came to Rome. Benedict XIII, however, made it seem like Innocent VII was the only one stopping the schism from ending. Innocent VII did not want to step down from his position, even if Benedict XIII did, because he believed he was the true pope. The Western Schism would continue for another 11 years.

On November 6, 1406, Pope Innocent VII died around 66 years old of a prolonged chronic illness.



Saint

August 23: St. Rose of Lima

(1586-1617)

The first canonized saint of the New World has one characteristic of all saints—the suffering of opposition—and another characteristic which is more for admiration than for imitation—excessive practice of mortification. She was born to parents of Spanish descent in Lima, Peru, at a time when South America was



in its first century of evangelization. She seems to have taken Catherine of Siena (April 29) as a model, in spite of the objections and ridicule of parents and friends.




