



Join the Holy Family Adult Choir






Our Catholic Heritage

152nd Pope - Saint Leo IX

Born in Alsace Lorraine, he was freely elected on March 12, 1049, by the clergy and the people of Rome. When he arrived, he entered Rome barefoot as a sign of humility. He called several synods to enforce ecclesiastic celibacy and to combat simony and heresy.



During his pontificate the doctrinal and political contrast began with the Church of the East. Quarreling over church practices, particularly the use of unleavened bread in the Eucharist, and dissenting opinions over papal supremacy in the Church. Patriarch Michael Cerularius, who was responsible for the schism, was excommunicated. Leo IX died April 18,1054. Just three months after his death, the definitive schism between the Greek Church and the Latin Church took place.







Pope Pius X is perhaps best remembered for his encouragement of the frequent reception of Holy Communion, especially by children. The second of ten children in a poor Italian family, Joseph Sarto became Pius X at 68, one of the 20th century's greatest popes.


