### A CUP OF JOE

**Greetings in Christ!** 

I want to start off with something important, but for it to make sense, I need to give you some background. By Church law, priests can only offer sacraments if they have what the Church calls "Faculties" from the Bishop. For example, if I want to pray my niece or nephew's wed-



ding and it's not within the diocese of Lansing, I have to get permission from the Bishop of the area where the wedding is, and I have to be given faculties. Every priest knows this; it is pounded into our brains from day one. If a priest is working or praying sacraments within a diocese without faculties from the local Bishop, it is a very serious matter.

I type all of these things because I've been contacted by a few parishioners in our area who have been approached by Fr. Joseph Birungi about donating to his ministries in Africa. When I contacted our diocese to check about it, it was made clear to me that he has not at any point received faculties from the Bishop or permission to raise money within our diocese.

Now, on to more pleasant things...

Our School Year starts on Tuesday and I am so excited. Please pray everyday for our little school. We are blessed beyond measure to be able to offer a Catholic education to all and a place that is safe, both physically and ideologically, to learn about God's Creation and how it all works within.

Your financial support is what makes this possible and on behalf of our school employees, students and their parents, I offer a big and sincere thank you.

God bless you all, I just love being your priest.



The seasons came and went, and fewer visitors came to the monastery, until one day the people stopped coming altogether.



#### **Our Catholic Heritage**

#### 100th Pope - Valentine

Born in Rome, he came from an upper-class noble Roman family. He was elected pope on September 1, 827. His election was not communicated to Emperor Lothair (possibly limited communication). Although a council in 796 had denied the laity a voice in papal elections, the laity were involved in Valentine's election.



Rumors were circulated that Valentine was really Eugene's son. He was devoted, pious, virtuous, and beloved by the Roman people. With this very brief pontificate lasting a little over a month, he did not have enough time to accomplish much in any area. Pope Valentine died October 10, 827. Cause of his death is unknown, but martyrdom was rumored.

#### Saint

### August 20: St. Bernard of Clairvaux (1091-1153)

In the year 1111, at the age of 20, Bernard left his home to join the monastic community of Citeaux. His five brothers, two uncles and some 30 young friends followed him into the monastery. Within four years a dying community had recovered enough vitality to establish a new house in the nearby valley of Wormwoods, with Bernard as abbot. "In dangers, in doubts, in difficulties, think of Mary, call upon Mary. Let not her name depart from your lips, never suffer it to leave your heart. And that you may more surely obtain the assistance of her prayer, neglect not to walk in her footsteps. With her for guide, you shall never go astray; while invoking



her, you shall never lose heart; so long as she is in your mind, you are safe from deception; while she holds your hand, you cannot fall; under her protection you have nothing to fear; if she walks before you, you shall not grow weary; if she shows you favor, you shall reach the goal" (St. Bernard).






