


St. Michael the Archangel

All my travels went well and I'm so glad to be home.





WHAT'S HAPPENING HERE

Family Formation

We are excited to introduce **Family Formation**, an exciting new model for Religious Education at Church of the Holy Family.

This dynamic, family-centered approach is rooted in the **Catechism of the Catholic Church** and brings children and parents together to grow in faith through shared experiences, prayer, and learning.

For grades 1st through 5th, formation will meet twice monthly on scheduled Sunday afternoons from 1:00 – 3:00 PM. Sessions will begin in the St. Joseph Center with joint activities for the whole family. Parents will then gather for catechesis while children meet in class-



rooms by grade level. Sessions conclude with prayer and fellowship as one faith community.

Students in **6th**, **7th**, **and 8th grades** will also meet during this time in a youth group-style format. Parents of these students are welcome to attend, but not required.

Sacramental Preparation for First Reconciliation and First Communion are included in Family Formation and will be introduced in the 2nd-grade sessions. The Parent meeting for these Sacraments will be held on **Wednesday**, **September 17**, **2025**, following the 6:00 pm Mass.

Confirmation Preparation is not included in Family Formation. Students seeking Confirmation are invited to attend the Confirmation Parent/Student meeting on **September 10, 2025**, following the 6:00 pm Mass. Students in Confirmation Preparation are not required to enroll or participate in Family Formation.

Enrollment is now open!

Cost: \$125 per family if registered by **September 1**, **2025** (late registration is \$150). Fees include materials, snacks, beverages, and sacramental prep.






Our Catholic Heritage

205th Pope - Gregory XII (1406-15)

Born in Venice as Angelo Corraro circa 1326 or 1327. He began his papacy on November 30, 1406, and resigned on July 4, 1415. He was one of the only popes to ever resign from the papacy until 600



years later in 2013 when Pope Benedict XVI stepped down. He served as Bishop of Castello in 1380, then ten years later, Latin Patriarch of Constantinople. As well, he was cardinal and a cardinal priest, eventually serving as administrator on behalf of the pope. As the tug of war and the Western Schism continued, in 1406 the papal elected 15 bishops agreed to support Angelo if he would renounce Benedict as an antipope. If Benedict would renounce his papacy, Angelo would agree to their terms. Angelo took his papal orders and almost immediately met with Benedict to discuss the papacy. The King of Naples announced that he sided with Angelo, who also had support from his wealthy family in Venice. The bishops who attended the Council of Pisa announced that they did not approve of either man and that Alexander V should be the next pope. His time as pope was one of the saddest periods of the Western Schism of which there were at least two others claiming to be the true pope. The next pope would not be named for another two years.

Pope Gregory XII died of natural causes on October 18, 1417.


Cenacle of Divine Mercy of St. Mary Cathedral

Saint

August 29: Martyrdom of St. John the Baptist

Scripture tells us that many people followed John looking to him for hope, perhaps in anticipation of some great messianic power. John never allowed himself the false honor of receiving these people for his own glory. He knew his calling was one of preparation. When the time came, he led his disciples to Jesus: "The next day John was there again with two of his disciples, and as he watched Jesus walk by, he said, 'Behold, the Lamb of God.' The two disciples heard what he said



and followed Jesus" (John 1:35-37). It is John the Baptist who has pointed the way to Christ. John's life and death were a giving over of self for God and other people. His simple style of life was one of complete detachment from earthly possessions. His heart was centered on God and the call that he heard from the Spirit of God speaking to his heart. Confident of God's grace, he had the courage to speak words of condemnation or repentance, of salvation.


