

I want to point out our Power House Saint Duo this week: On Tuesday, August 27th, we celebrate St. Monica and on Wednesday, August 28th, we celebrate her son, St. Augustine. For those who don't know, St. Augustine was a bit of a moral trainwreck, who wasted 30+ years of his life in debauchery. His Mother prayed for him every day and never gave up hope for him to repent and become Christian. St. Augustine gave his heart to the Lord and is now the most quoted Saint in our catechism. His writings are vital to our faith as he wrestled so lovingly to find and live the truth. I just love his honesty about his struggles and his hope in Jesus. As an interesting note, he is considered to be the first person to write an autobiography. He wrote his life story in a book called "The Confessions" and referred to himself in the first person. No one that we know of has done that before.

I will close with my favorite quotation from that book. It's something he wrote shortly after he gave his life to Jesus. I pray you enjoy it and draw the same kind of strength and joy from it that I do:

Late have I loved you, O Beauty so ancient, O Beauty so new.

Late have I loved you!

You were within me but I was outside myself, and there I sought you.

In my weakness, I ran after the beauty of the things you have made.

You were with me, but I was not with you.

You called, you cried, and you pierced my deafness. You shined forth, shined brightly, and dispelled my blindness.

You sent forth your fragrance, I breathed it in, and now I long for you.

I have tasted you, and I hunger and thirst for you more. You have touched me, and I crave your peace.



## Our Catholic Heritage

### 153rd Pope - Victor II

Born in Bavaria, he was elected on April 16, 1055. His election came after a papal vacancy of one year. Gebhard, his given name, was a native of the Kingdom of Germany in the Holy Roman Empire. He received an abjuration of Berengarius and blessed Henry III on his death-



bed. He continued the works of reforming the Church by following the standard set by his predecessor. He worked to help Godfrey of Lorraine re-establish his power in southern Italy. Victor II was one of a series of Germanborn popes who led the Gregorian Reform. His place of birth is unknown. He died July 28, 1057, in Arezzo, Tuscany, Italy.





"Well, my mom did the best she could, but she had her own problems, and so I was mostly raised by my grandmother. So, I was thinking if it was okay with you good people, I would send one to my grandmother too!" Joan had to use all her strength not to burst into tears. There were four hundred inmates in the prison that day, and every single one wrote a Mother's Day card. That's four hundred Holy Moments. In fact, Joan and her company ended up mailing 657 Mother's Day cards for the inmates.
