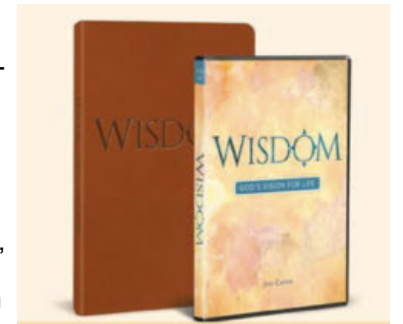

## Our Catholic Heritage

### 50th Pope – Anastasius II

Born in Rome, elected November 24, 496. Anastasius II was named pope largely with support from a faction that wanted to improve relations between the West and the Eastern churches and end the Acacian schism. The church had been in a serious doctrinal dispute since 484. Anastasius II sent two bishops to Constantinople to meet with the Byzantine Emperor and work to end the schism. During his pontificate he brought about the conversion of Clovis, king of the Franks and his people. Died November 19, 498, and is buried in St. Peter's Basilica.
