Amen.

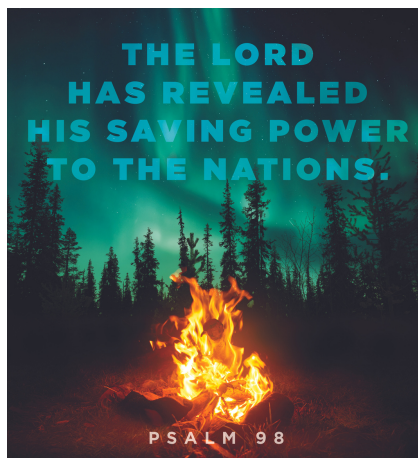

2 Kings 5:14-17 / 144


