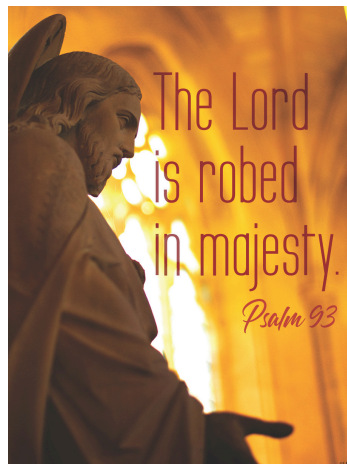

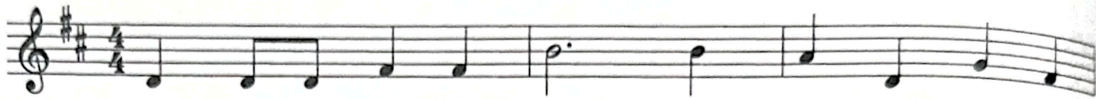
## St. Michael the Archangel

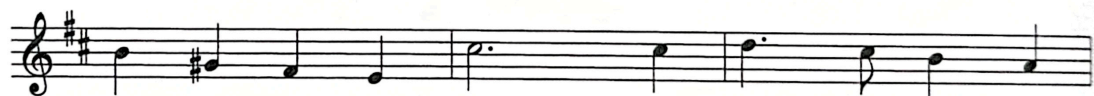

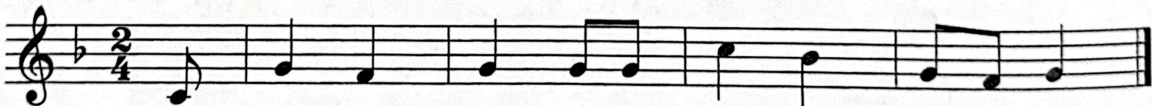
Dn 7:13-14
