This command I have received from my Father."

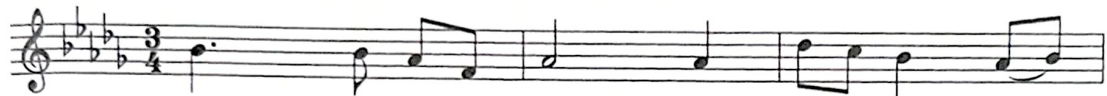

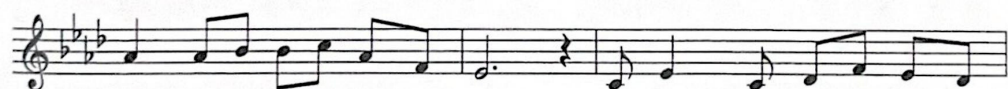
