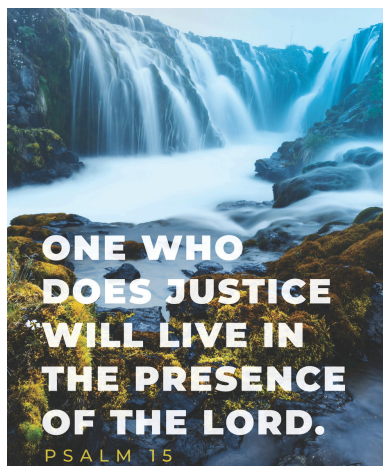

St. Michael the Archangel

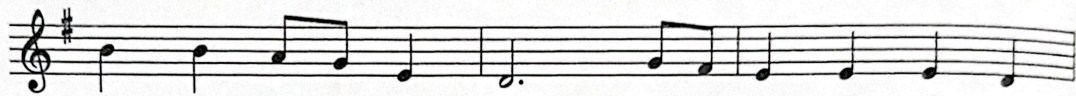

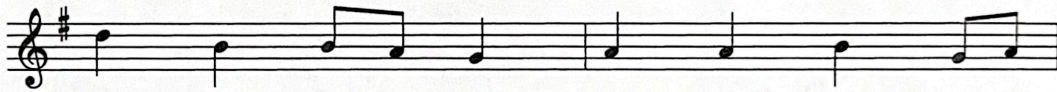

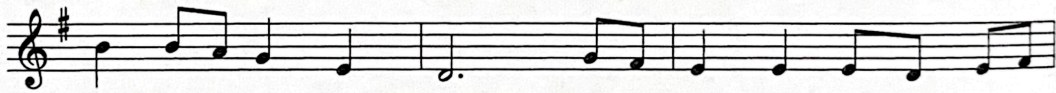

and it will not be taken from her."


39 Psalm 25: To You, O Lord



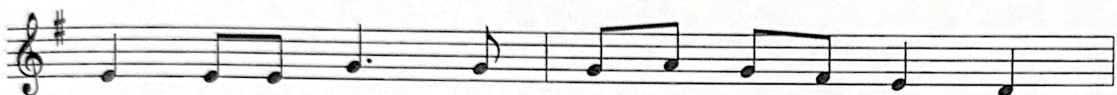

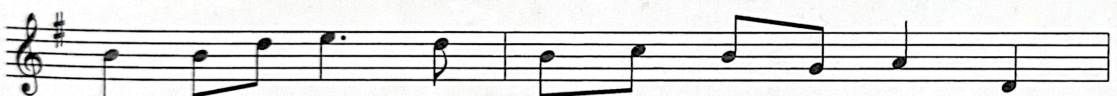
