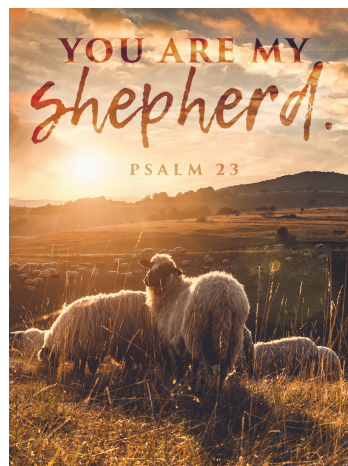

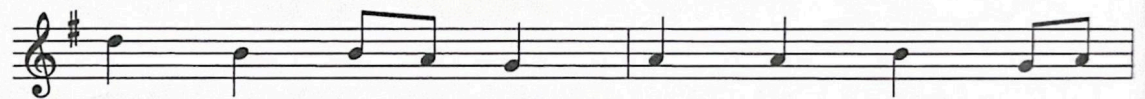

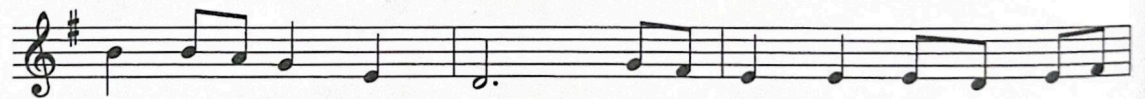

Jer 23:1-6

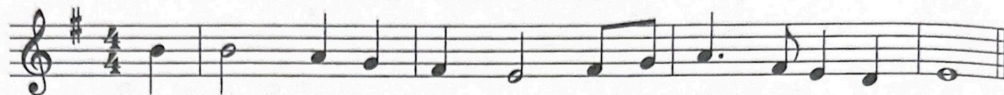
Woe to the shepherds

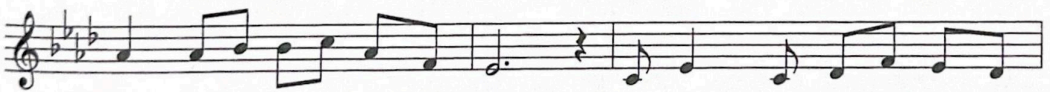

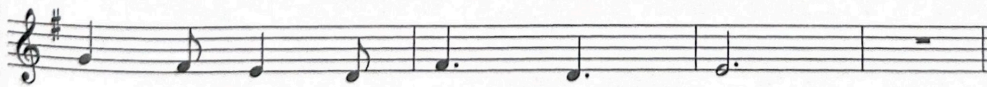
