Amen.

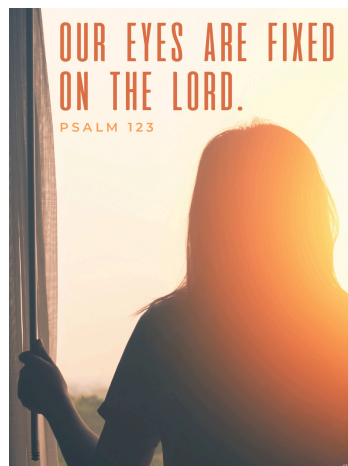
