St. Michael the Archangel

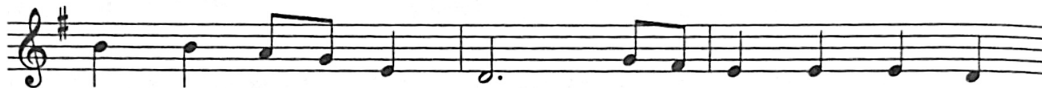
