
First Reading

remains in me and I in him.

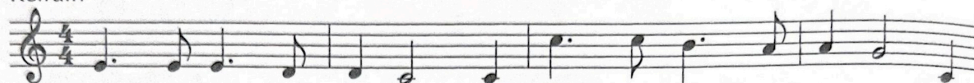
Just as the living Father sent me
