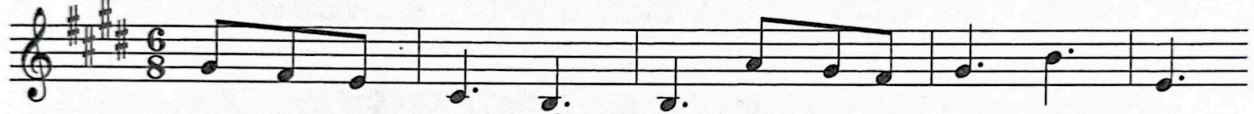
St. Michael the Archangel

Amen.

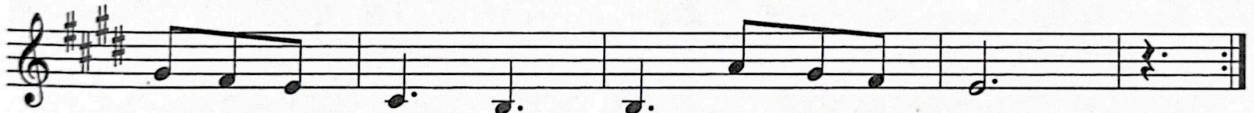

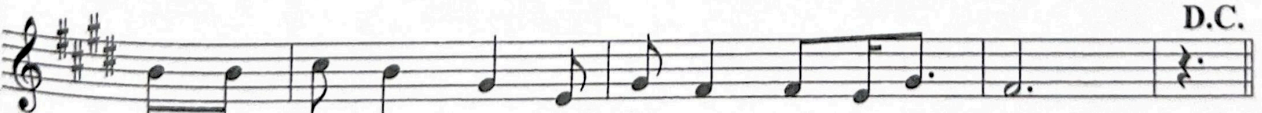

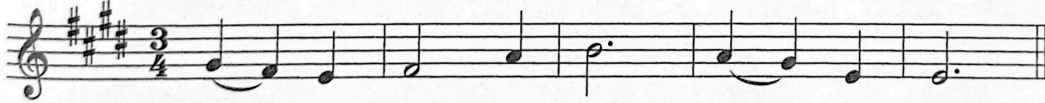

He makes the deaf hear and the mute speak."

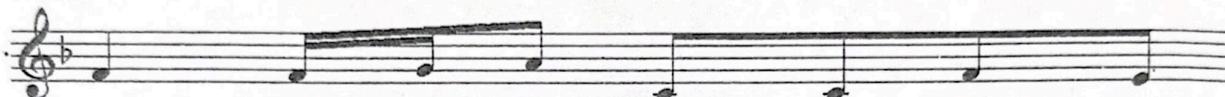

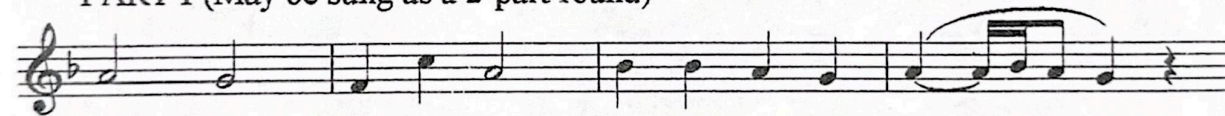

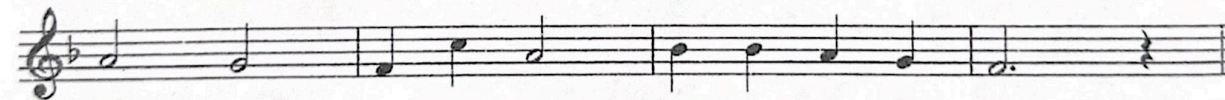
